were held for **SUPPORT GROUPS**.

Total service requests **INCREASED 4%** from FY18.



31,717 VICTIMS

received **ONE-ON-ONE COUNSELING**. This includes safety planning, assistance with obtaining basic needs, etc. Total service requests **INCREASED** <1% from FY18.



4,459 EVENTS

were held promoting **COMMUNITY EDUCATION**. Total services provided **INCREASED 8%** from FY18.
